Re: GoTriangle's Rail Operations and Maintenance Facility proposal

Dear community member:

Thank you for your interest in the Rail Operations and Maintenance Facility proposed as part of Durham and Orange counties' light-rail project. You are receiving this letter because you signed up to speak at the Oct. 9, 2018, hearing before the Durham Planning Commission. We understand that some neighbors have concerns about GoTriangle's rezoning application, and we want to reassure you that we have been listening. When we held meetings in your neighborhood in 2015 and 2017, we identified top concerns as the noise the facility might generate, how it might look, visual buffers and safety. We have taken these concerns into account in our design of the facility.

To help explain the selection of the site, the facility's design and how comments have been addressed, we have prepared a set of answers to some of the most common concerns we heard at the Planning Commission hearing. We hope you find our responses helpful, and we encourage you to share this with your neighbors and anyone else who may be interested.
