FOR PEDESTRIANS:

- INCREASE YOUR VISIBILITY BY CARRYING A FLASHLIGHT AND WEARING REFLECTIVE CLOTHING
- IT'S SAFEST TO WALK ON A SIDEWALK, BUT IF YOU MUST WALK ON THE STREET, WALK FACING TRAFFIC
- CROSS THE STREET AT DESIGNATED CROSSWALKS AND BE SURE TO WATCH FOR VEHICLES TURNING LEFT OR RIGHT, AND ENTERING AND EXITING PARKING SPACES AND DRIVEWAYS

FOR CYCLISTS:

- RIDE IN THE SAME DIRECTION AS TRAFFIC
- IF YOU RIDE AT NIGHT, GET A LIGHT! USE WHITE FRONT LIGHTS AND RED REAR LIGHTS AND REFLECTORS
- OBEY ALL TRAFFIC LAWS – STOP AT STOP SIGNS AND RED LIGHTS AS IF YOU WERE A CAR

TRANSIT SERVICE CHANGES...

GoTriangle is enhancing transit options and reliability across the Triangle with several route and service changes beginning in early November. Highlights include hourly weekday service on Route **ZWX** between Wendell, Zebulon, and Downtown Raleigh, and expanded all-day Route **WRX** service from Wake Forest to Triangle Town Center with peak-hour express trips to Downtown Raleigh. These improvements, including GoTriangle's operation of Route **WRX** starting **November 9th**, are designed to provide riders with more convenient and dependable travel throughout northeastern Wake County.

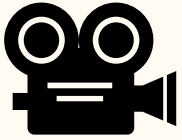

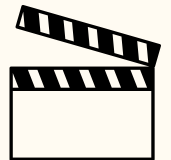
