The solicitation document has been updated in eVP and on the GoTriangle website to incorporate the changes outlined in Addendum No. 1. All revisions are highlighted in **red text**.

Questions & Answers:

1. We are already a current vendor with approved equal on file and currently being used by Go Triangle- do we have to resubmit these items?
 - a. Yes, vendors must submit a responsive bid to be considered regardless of previous or current status.

2. Is the bid an item by item in each section or is all item per category to be considered?
 - a. Please reference the solicitation scope of services section two (2).

3. My company is interested in bidding on the OEM parts for the Chrysler, Dodge, Jeep Ram vehicles in your fleet. While looking over the information, I wanted to confirm we would just be bidding under section F for Miscellaneous.
 - a. Please reference the solicitation scope of services section two (2).

4. I see the specifications, but I am not totally clear about the interpretation. For example, you list Fleetguard filters. If WIX makes the exact filter (branded as WIX), is this acceptable? Also, for many of the brake parts, Dayton carries these items. They are spec'd in Meritor, Haldex, Bendix etc. Is Dayton acceptable? I can quote many other brands as well.
 - a. Refer to section Scope of Service Subsection 4.

5. What are the delivery requirements for parts after PO is received
 - a. Please refer to Attachment B – Cost Proposal, Column K: Delivery Upon Order (business days). The bidder shall specify the anticipated delivery timeframe, in business days, from the date of purchase order issuance.

 6. How many Go Triangle facilities will we deliver parts to?
 - a. One facility, located at 5201 Nelson Rd, Morrisville, NC 27560.

 7. When do you anticipate the finalized bid going into effect?
 - a. Refer to section Instructions to Bidders subsection 1

 8. How are manufacturer price increases handled? Both of our parts manufacturers, Paccar & Cummins, typically have price increases twice a year, in July and January.
 - a. Refer to the Terms and Conditions subsection 3.4

 9. What happens if there are new tariffs that are assessed on parts that previously did not have a tariff, or if a tariff is increased? Does the bidder have to absorb the loss?
 - a. Refer to the Terms and Conditions subsection 3.4

 10. How long will the bid be in effect? Is it 2 years w/ a 1 year extension, or is it 2 years w/ a total of 3 1-year extensions
 - a. The initial contract will be awarded for a term of two (2) years, with the option to extend for one (1) additional year, and maximum contract term not to exceed three (3) years.

11. Are there any NC E-Procurement fees, or any other fees that will be charged to the bidder after the parts are invoiced?

- a. No, there will be no additional fees for the bidders. Please refer to the Instructions to Offerors section 6. Bid Delivery.

12. What are the payment terms for Go Triangle?

- a. GoTriangle payment terms are net 30 upon delivery and acceptance of goods or services.

13. Is there a Performance Bond requirement if awarded any part of the bid

- a. No bond is required for this solicitation.
