RFP Title Vehicle Washing and Detailing Service

1. The solicitation document has been updated on the GoTriangle website to incorporate the changes outlined in this Addendum No. One (1). All revisions are in red text.
2. The Terms and Conditions Section 2. Contract Term has been revised and replaced with the following:

2. Contract Term

The term of the resulting contract shall begin on the date of execution and continue for an initial period of one (1) year, unless canceled, terminated, or otherwise extended as permitted. At its sole discretion, GoTriangle may extend the contract for an additional one (1) year period, for a total maximum term not to exceed two (2) years.

3. Questions & Answers:

1. Can you provide previous pricing for these services??
 - a. This is a new service but historically we've spent an estimated \$45,000 for fraction of the services.
 2. What is the estimated number of vehicles included in the contract?
 - a. Please refer to section Scope of Services subsection 5
 3. What are the service frequency requirements?

 4. What are the vehicle types included in the fleet?
 - a. Please refer to section Scope of Services subsection 5.1 and 5.2
 5. What are the current service structure and performance expectations?

6. Will a site visit or facility tour be arranged prior to proposal submission?
 - a. A site visit can be arranged after award
7. Are water connections available at both service locations, and will the contractor be required to provide all water necessary to perform the services?
 - a. Water should be provided by the contractor.
8. Are designated washing bays available at either facility for vehicle washing and detailing activities?
 - a. There are no designated washing bays. Vehicles are not to be moved and must be washed on-site
9. Are contractors required to provide wastewater containment and recovery systems, or are existing facility systems available for use?
 - a. Contractors are required to block off storm drains to prevent runoff. Any recovery or recycling systems used during the service are the responsibility of the contractor.
10. Can GoTriangle provide additional information regarding the vehicle types included in the estimated quantities (manufacturer, model, and approximate size of the paratransit and support vehicles)?
 - a. Vehicles can range from 40-foot Gillig buses, Ford Cutaways, Dodge Grand Caravans, Ford Fusions, Ford F-150s, Nissan Pathfinders, and Chevrolet Malibu's and Traverses.
11. The RFP references that 40-foot bus services may be required on an as-needed basis. Can GoTriangle provide an estimated annual volume or anticipated frequency for these services?
 - a. The number of 40-foot buses will depend on the status of our current wash system. If the washing system is down, the volume could range from 40 to 65 buses. Services would be needed for as long as the washing system remains out of service.
12. Is electrical power available at the service locations for contractor equipment, if needed?
 - a. Electrical outlets are available on-site; however, our previous vendors have always provided their own equipment and power sources as needed.

13. Are there preferred service hours on Saturdays and Sundays, or is scheduling flexible provided the vehicles are completed within the required service window?
 - a. Our typical coverage on Saturdays and Sundays is from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM. This schedule allows us to inspect and account for all vehicles, ensure proper oversight, and maintain accurate tracking of fleet status. There may be some flexibility with these hours.
