### I. Questions & Answers:

1. Please clarify which compensation structure will govern the resulting contract: a monthly retainer (as reflected in Attachment B) or milestone-based payments (as reflected in Section 3.1).
  - a. Refer to section II. Scope of Work, and Terms and Conditions section 3. Invoicing and Compensation, subsection 3.1.
2. If the project is milestone-based payments, can GoTriangle advise when these payments will be established and how the monthly retainer pricing relates?
  - a. Refer to section II. Scope of Work, and Terms and Conditions section 3. Invoicing and Compensation, subsection 3.1
3. Please confirm a cover page, cover letter, and table of contents may be included and are exempt from page limits.
  - a. Refer to section IV. Instructions to Offerors section 4. Contents of Submittal, subsection 4.1.
4. Should the full proposal be combined in a single pdf? Or should the cost proposal be submitted as an excel file?
  - a. Offerors may submit the proposal as a single PDF or submit the cost proposal as a separate Excel file. The format is left to the Offeror's discretion, provided all required proposal components are submitted by the proposal deadline.

5. Would GoTriangle consider an additional page of text for each of sections 4.3 Congressional Engagement, 4.4. Annual Appropriations, and 4.5. Competitive Discretionary Grant Programs? If not, can additional information be included as an annex outside of page limitations?
  - a. Refer to the Instructions to Offerors section 4. Content of Submittal.
6. If an Offeror's Exceptions was submitted by the deadline, does it need to be included with the overall submission package? If so, does it need to be submitted as an excel file or into a single PDF with the other proposed pieces.
